No matter the scenario, you respond by doing whatever you normally would at work. It's that's easy. So, if you'd like to try to earn your **Gateways ECE Credential Level 2** and up to 12 college credits in a matter of minutes, follow these three simple steps:



Fill out the enrollment form on [Gateways website](#). You will receive an email with instructions on scheduling your virtual assessment.



Schedule the virtual assessment anytime it's convenient for you—day or night. You can take your assessment on a computer, laptop, tablet, or smartphone, provided the device has access to the internet and a camera.



Show your competencies by completing the virtual assessments at your scheduled time. When your assessment is over, a video recording of your assessment will be sent to faculty at your local community college or university to score your performance on twelve competencies in five areas:

- Human Growth and Development
- Interactions, Relationships and Environments
- Family and Community Relationships
- Health, Safety, and Well-Being
- Personal and Professional Development

You earn college credit and progress toward earning your Gateways ECE Credential Level 2 when you demonstrate the desired knowledge, skills, abilities, and behaviors. You might even earn the credential and all 12 credits in minutes. Even partial awards allow you to **save time and money** by requiring you to take only the parts you need—and nothing more!
