# DEPARTMENT OF ALLIED HEALTH TECHNICAL STANDARDS FOR THE RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

#### **Technical Standards**

For admission to and participation in the Radiologic Technology Program, applicants must meet nonacademic technical standards that enable students to engage in educational and training activities that do not endanger them or others. Program technical standards are mailed to applicants along with the program information packet.

Please read the following statements that identify the Technical Standards appropriate to Radiologic Technology and answer the inquiry provided below.

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## The Radiologic Technologist must have sufficient strength, motor coordination and manual dexterity to:

- 1. Transport, move, lift and transfer patients from a wheelchair or cart to an x-ray table or to a patient bed.
- 1. Move, adjust and manipulate a variety of radiographic equipment, including the physical transport of mobile radiographic machines, in order to arrange and align the equipment with respect to the patient and the image receptor according to established procedure and standards of speed and accuracy.

# The Radiologic Technologist must have the mental and intellectual capacity to:

- 1. Calculate and select proper technical exposure factors according to the individual needs of the patient and the requirement of the procedure's standards and accuracy.
- 1. Review and evaluate the recorded images on radiographs for the purpose of identifying proper patient positioning, accurate procedural sequencing, proper radiographic exposure, and other appropriate and pertinent technical qualities.

## The Radiologic Technologist must be capable of:

- 1. Handling stressful situations related to technical and procedural standards and patient care situations.
- 1. Providing physical and emotional support to the patient during the radiographic procedure(s), being able to respond to situations requiring first aid and providing emergency care to the patient in the absence of, or until the physician arrives.
- 1. Communicating verbally in an effective manner in order to direct patients during radiographic examinations.
- 1. Reading and interpreting patient charts and requisitions for radiographic examinations.
